Further, the Trilogy is a multi-faceted system offering various treatment modalities, such as Image Modulated Radiation Therapy (IMRT), Image Guided Radiation Therapy (IGRT), Stereotactic Radiosurgery, Stereotactic Body Radiation Therapy, 3D Conformal Radiation Therapy, and Electron Beam Therapy.
