

UCSD Radiation Oncology South Bay Offers Free Breast and Cervical Cancer Screenings to Qualifying Women

Free breast and cervical cancer screenings now offered at UCSD Radiation Oncology South Bay to women eligible for Medi-Cal Family PACT Program

UCSD Radiation Oncology South Bay has become a member of Medi-Cal's Family PACT (Planning, Access, Care and Treatment) Program in order to help serve the diverse South Bay population in the fight against cancer. The South Bay clinic, located in Chula Vista, is proud to now offer free breast and cervical cancer screenings to women who qualify for this program.

Through the Family PACT Program, UCSD Radiation Oncology South Bay offers mammograms and clinical breast exams for the detection of breast cancer, and Pap tests for the detection of cervical cancer. According to the American Cancer Society (ACS), most doctors agree that these early detection tests save thousands of lives each year and greatly improve the chances for successful treatment. The ACS recommends that women begin receiving clinical breast exams in their 20's and mammograms at age 40, and begin receiving Pap tests no later than age 21.

The highly skilled clinical staff at UCSD Radiation Oncology South Bay is currently offering free screenings to eligible women by appointment every Friday from 8:00 am until 4:30 pm. If screening results suggest that a biopsy is necessary, and biopsy results are positive for cancer, the patient will be recommended to other programs that provide financial assistance for cancer treatment.
